The Preschool of First Presbyterian Church has been in operation since 1959. We provide individual and group experiences adapted to the needs of three, four and five year old children. We share with parents some of the responsibility for sound social, physical, emotional, intellectual and spiritual development.

Daily sessions are planned and directed by our professionally trained director, Mrs. Brenda Francis.

Each class is complete with two or three parents who are scheduled to work under the direction of Mrs. Francis.
